Rosemary



Rosemary is an aromatic evergreen shrub with leaves similar to hemlock needles. It can withstand droughts, surviving a severe lack of water for lengthy periods. Forms range from upright to trailing; the upright forms can reach 1.5 m (5 ft) tall. Upon cultivation, the leaves, twigs, and flowering apices are extracted for use. Rosemary is used as a decorative plant in gardens where it may have pest control. The leaves are used to flavor various foods, such as stuffing and roast meats.

Rosemary shampoo for oily hair

- 1 tablespoon neutral shampoo
- 1 egg yolk
- 3 drops rosemary essential oil

Mix the ingredients well and beat them until forming a creamy paste. Shampoo your hair as you would normally. Do not save any remaining shampoo since it does not keep well.
